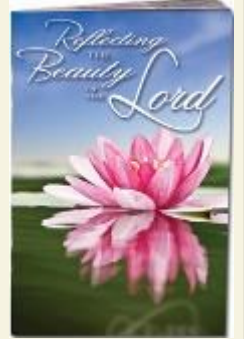

WELCOME PASTOR JEFF KIPP OF CHOSEN PEOPLE MINISTRIES

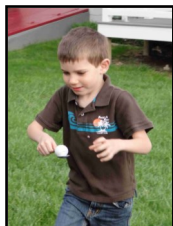
OUR JEWISH ROOTS



Today, we welcome Pastor Jeff Kipp of Chosen People Ministries. He will preach a message entitled, **Our Jewish Roots**. Pastor Jeff Kipp, as a young, long-haired, Jewish hippie, met Jesus through the ministry of Dr. Michael Silverburg in Taos, New Mexico. Both were fellow Jews and fellow New Yorkers! Chosen People Ministries was founded in 1894 by Hungarian Rabbi Leopold Cohn, who came to believe that Jesus is the Messiah of Israel! From those humble beginnings in Brooklyn, New York, the ministry has grown to become worldwide with an unwavering commitment in bringing the gospel message of salvation in Jesus "to the Jew first and to the Gentile."

COMMUNITY MEAL NEEDS YOUR HELP

The twice per month Community Meal continues to feed between 60 - 80 guests. We have seen some new faces over the last few months, some of them young folks. Our cupboards are looking a little bare and we are coming to our church family to help us fill them. You have all been so generous in the past and we are praying you can, again, help us provide for our brothers and sisters in need. Over the years we have found that some donated items just cannot be made into a meal for 60 people, so we are requesting specific items: Large Cans (#10 when possible) - vegetables, spaghetti sauce, tomato sauce, apple sauce, cheese sauce (mild), cream of chicken soup, cream of mushroom soup, tuna, pickles, pudding, fruit. Pasta - spaghetti, elbow macaroni, lasagna, egg noodles, box stuffing (chicken), instant potatoes, ranch, Italian salad dressing, coleslaw dressing. If you can think of other items that can be incorporated into a meal for a large group of people, we will be happy to have them. As always, we are ever grateful for the continued support of our church family, and if you ever want to be truly blessed, come join us as we serve those in need.
