Dear Brother Bob,

I went to preach at Thamakiang Church on 24 of August, I went up there again to hold meeting with our evangelists for August and to help them pouring Church floor. We had 14 in all; 3 church members, 11 evangelists. One Thai non-Christian came to help. Ladies were cooking for us. I taught the Bible on the 27th for one hour. We worked the whole day on 28 till 5:30 pm and we had dinner at 6, our night Bible class began at 7 pm to 10 pm non-stop class.

After that I drove back to Chiangmai. I helped people carry their rice to Chiangmai. I arrived home at 1 am. There are more works are waiting for me. I got up and 6 am till 11 pm. I do my reading at night. See the pictures that we are working together. We finished pouring the Church floor. Now Insorn and members are still working there. By your offerings we bought cement bags and gravel and sands.
