NSCC Homeless Outreach/HELP NEEDED

NSCC Missions Department has traditionally tried to reach out across the world and at the same time not forget our own neighbors. In the last couple years, our church has become highly involved meeting needs of people in our community who are homeless – whether short term transitional or longer term. We serve the Community Meal two Saturday's per month; NSCC provides blanket boxes and backpacks filled with useful items for those who do not have ongoing regular housing; through Brother's Keeper and Sister's Helper (needs are typically communicated through text, email and Facebook) lots of items have been donated and given away to help those in need. Many Sunday morning visitors have come through the personal invitation of those who have been reaching out in the name of Jesus. NSCC has become a resource for passing used furniture from one hand to another. Many folks who are getting re-established have been blessed by a single item, such as a bed, to nearly all items needed to set up housekeeping again. **HELP IS NEEDED** especially in this area of moving furniture. 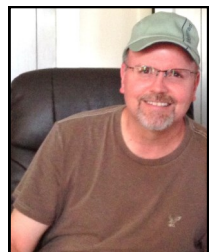

The team will also be visiting village churches and Pastors and discussing the possibility of future partnerships.
