### MEN'S BREAKFAST is coming!

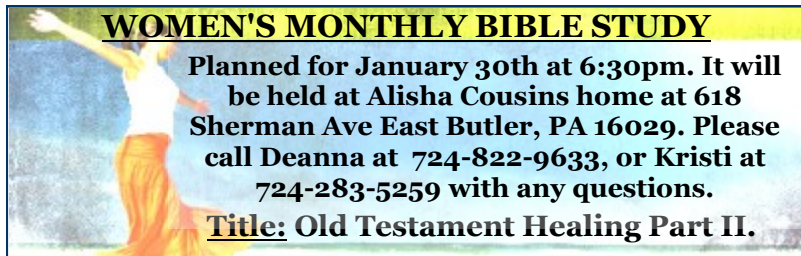
