A Word From Pastor Bob



Today's message is about ATTITUDE! We will be taking a peek into the lives of a sister and two brothers- Miriam and Aaron and Moses. We will discover the worst and the best about our attitudes from their interaction with one another and with the Lord. The best short advice about attitude that I have ever read comes from Pastor Chuck Swindoll and completes my article to you for this week. Here it is: "The longer I live, the more I realize the impact of attitude on life. Attitude, to me, is more important than facts. It is more important than the past, than education, than money, than circumstances, than failures, than successes, than what other people think or say or do. It is more important than appearance, giftedness or skill. It will make or break a company...a church....a home. The remarkable thing is we have a choice

every day regarding the attitude we will embrace for that day. We cannot change our past...we cannot change the fact that people will act in a certain way. We cannot change the inevitable. The only thing we can do is play on the one string we have, and that is our attitude...I am convinced that life is 10% what happens to me and

90% how I react to it. And so it is with you...we are in charge of our attitudes."
