MEXICO MISSIONS TRIP MEETING TODAY!

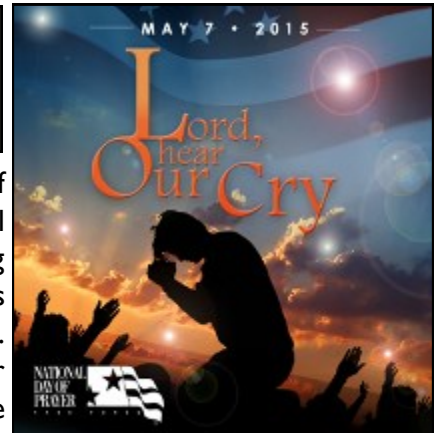

A NEW NOTE FROM OUR TREASURER

I want to thank everyone for contributing to the Lord and His work here at North Street Christian Church. I also appreciate many of you helping make our volunteer counters' jobs easier by using the suggestions that were mentioned in the NSCC announcements in March. Two new suggestions have been added that will help make our job easier when you prepare an offering envelope. When you make an offering to the church you can help us tremendously by following the below suggestions:

1. Write your name in full on the envelope, like (John Blackburn.)
2. Write the contribution amount on the appropriate line or lines on the envelope which directs where the offering is to be used, (like \$40 General.)
3. Write the check number on the envelope or write the word cash on the envelope, depending on the type of contribution given. Use separate envelopes if both types of contributions are given. On a blank space write check # or write cash.
4. If you are contributing more than one check on the same Sunday, please use one envelope and write all the check numbers with the respective amounts beside each check number, along with how the church is to use the gifts.
5. If you are contributing one check, even if your gift is for a series of Sundays, it is only necessary that you fill out one envelope.
6. If you have previously provided your address and phone number on your envelopes at least three times before, it is not necessary to provide them again unless you move or your phone number changes.
7. It is not necessary to write your envelope number if you have already been assigned one. Your name has been recorded as being assigned with that number with us.
8. In order to provide integrity please do not put cash in envelopes without marking how much you have placed in them and please mark your envelope with the amount of your gifts into all the places on the envelope that your gift is to go to and please do not leave it to the counters to decide how much your total gift is.
9. Please also train children to write things in the correct places as described above.

I know the ladies who do the counting will be grateful if you would follow these helpful hints as it will relieve them of making decisions for you and also allow them to get home earlier. Thank you for all that you do for the Lord and for showing you love Him by giving your offerings.
