Praying First and Foremost: The visible works of the Christian life and ministry are more easily fulfilled than



the inner disciplines. We can measure how many lessons we have taught, how many people we have spent time with, how many meetings we have attended and how many times we have gone to church. Doing the outward works without the reality of a developed spiritual inner fiber just wears out a servant and he/she finds himself/herself mired up in busyness rather than being fulfilled in fruitfulness.

In his book, <u>Power Through Prayer</u>, E.M. Bounds (1835-1913) wrote, "We are constantly on a stretch, if not on a strain, to devise new methods, new plans, new organizations to advance the Church and secure enlargement and efficiency for the gospel. This trend of the day has a tendency to lose sight of the man or sink the man in the plan or organization. God's plan is to make much of the man, far more of him than of anything else. Men are God's method. The Church is looking for better methods; God is looking for better men." God continues to build men and women for His purposes. Let us pray first and foremost.
