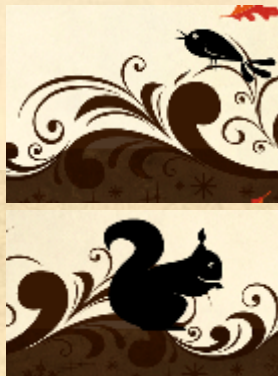
CASAS POR CRISTO FUNDRAISER
