We continue to make the effort to reach out in ways that will personally touch those in need by promoting area-specific projects. We have been involved in ministries such as a children's home in Thailand, to ministries in Nicaragua, Paraguay and Brazil. Connie's Home Orphanage:

~Our partnership with Connie's Home Orphanage is ongoing in Chiang Mai, Thailand. There is a constant need to provide milk and formula for the children which costs approximately \$400.00 a month.

~The orphanage is also in need of a washing machine. Their current machine is very old and no longer cleaning their clothes. A new machine will cost a minimum of \$300.00.



Chiang Mai Women's Prison Ministry:



~We are also aware of a need for Bibles at a local Juvenile Women's Prison in Chiang Mai, Thailand. Weekly Bible studies are held with the young inmates and we would like to provide each girl with her own Bible. The guards have actually seen and commented on what a difference these studies have made and now require the girls to attend the Bible study as a weekly activity.
