Senior Citizen's Fall Trip

This coming **Thursday, October 13** is the annual Senior Citizen's fall trip. At 9:00 a.m. the group will board two vans to begin the day's journey. The itinerary includes travel from Butler to the north, traveling through the Allegheny Forest to Mt. Jewett, PA in order to visit the Visitor's Center and Sky Walk at the Kinzua Railroad Bridge State Park. The former railroad viaduct has been reinvented as the Kinzua Sky Walk — a spectacular walkway that allows the public to "Walk the Tracks Across the Sky." A partial glass-bottomed observation deck enables visitors to look down at the remaining towers supporting the historic

structure. As the group journeys throughout the day, stops will be made along the way to check out the mountain views and just about anything else that looks interesting passing through places such as Lucinda, Leeper, Vowinckel, Marienville and Kane! Participants can purchase lunch along the way or bring a sack lunch. Dinner will be enjoyed at the Allegheny Grille/Foxburg Inn located along the river in Foxburg, PA.
