## **MISSIONS MINISTRY AT NSCC**

One of our ministry departments at North Street Christian Church is the Missions Department. This ministry is responsible for developing a mission ministry in the Church, and administrating monthly mission distributions. Our mission ministry is overseen by two of our Shepherd/Overseers, Matt Eckert and Dane Kerr who hold six to ten working meetings per year. In the meetings, organizational details are sharpened, reports are received and prayer is practiced.

One of the bullet points of our purpose statement says this – "We will purposefully send and be sent into the whole world to advance the Kingdom of God!" Our core values include affecting culture with Biblical truth, being involved firsthand in world missions and the practice of sincere, authentic Christianity offering God our best! The NSCC Missions Budget is generated by designating 15% of General Funds received to be given to kingdom causes. In addition to these regular funds, any designated gifts are applied in full to the missions as indicated by the giver. Our expected regular mission income for 2017 is estimated at \$40,000.00 to \$45,000.00 plus designated gifts. In 2016 NSCC sent over \$80,000.00 to the fields white unto harvest. (John 4:35)

A total of \$3,400.00 plus designated gifts is given monthly to the above mentioned ministries. In addition we receive and distribute gifts to Jon and Bonna Ray, the NSCC Light of Life Christian Outreach and the NSCC Community Meal. Annually, we also receive special funds for the LifeChoices Ministry, the Gideons and Samaritan's Purse. We also find ourselves raising funds to send groups to build houses in Mexico with Casas Por Cristo!
