

Bible Study I in Room 102 Survey of the Old Testament

This course is a video series with discussion as led by Gary Saeler and George Rader. The video teaching is led by Bible Teacher, Dr. Ed Hindson who is the host of The King Is Coming telecast and is also Assistant Chancellor, Distinguished Professor, and Dean of the Institute of Biblical Studies and the School of Religion at Liberty University in Virginia. Dr. Hindson has also written over 40 books, including Final Signs; Approaching Armageddon and The Illustrated Bible Survey. The class is now beginning the Book of Leviticus. You are welcome to join in any Sunday!

Bible Study II in Room 101 Answers Academy by Answers In Genesis

This one of a kind study series will equip you to understand the world through "biblical glasses", and to answer the questions our culture is asking about the authority and accuracy of the Bible. During the 13 DVD lessons, you will discover why it is vital to provide logical answers to skeptics, and how to give those answers with a solid understanding of what the Bible says about the relevance of Genesis, geology, and astronomy. Viewers learn a solid creation based worldview and that, contrary to popular belief, operational science runs counter to the idea of evolution and millions of years. The facts of nature, rightly interpreted, provide an irrefutable case for the accuracy and trustworthiness of the book that claims to be the inspired word of the Creator Himself. You can join Terry Hartman, Dennis Muir and Dane Kerr as they team up to lead this class in Room 101.

As Pastor Bob preached on Sunday, January 8, we discovered nine common factors (Acts 3-5) between the early church and the church today as we experience boldness in the dedication to and the proclamation of "no other name" but the name of JESUS! Here they are the nine factors:

- 1. Repentance leading to times of refreshing Acts 3:19
- 2. NO OTHER NAME Acts 4:11, 12
- 3. Time spent with Jesus Acts 4:13
- 4. Corporate Prayer for Boldness Acts 4:23–31
- 5. Great awe toward God Acts 5:11
- 6. Desire to obey God rather than man Acts 5:29
- 7. Ready to see the hand of God at work Hebrews 11:6
- 8. Consider it worthy to suffer for the Name Acts 5:40–42
- 9. Continual witness to Jesus as the Christ Acts 5:42

Pastor Bob has asked the congregation to join him in prayer concerning these ministry matters:

- ~Building a House in Mexico/we still need approximately \$2000.00 and 6 more people to go!
- ~Use of a house on our campus for the beginning of a maternity home ministry in partnership with Life Choices ministry
- ~Light of Life Community Outreach/daily drop-in center on our campus/continual need for volunteers/cooks/supplies
- ~Community Meal ministry need more volunteers/cooks/ serve the 2nd and 3rd Saturday of each month
- ~Rearrangement of our building and property offices in lower level/new entrance with lift from ground level to main level on west side of building/we have \$230,000.00 in hand will likely need another \$100,000 to \$150,000
