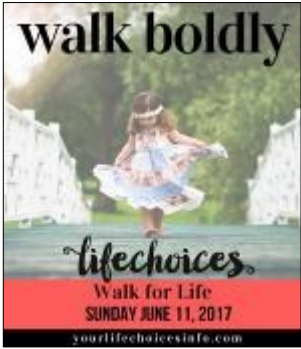
Thursday Morning Sr Citz Bible Study

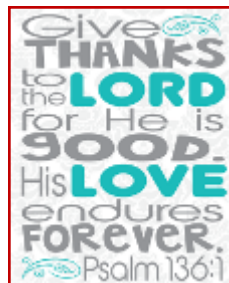
Play the Organ?

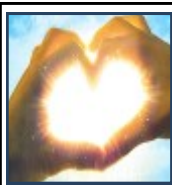
