Hurricane Relief Offering

The 10 Commandments and The Beatitudes In Stone

In the spring of 2018, NSCC will install a two-sided, polished, black granite monument which will be chiseled with the Ten Commandments and the Two Greatest Commandments on one side and the Beatitudes on the other side. The monument will be over 5 feet tall and 40 inches wide and become the centerpiece of our Church yard. It will be dedicated to the glory of God, the advancement of the Gospel of Jesus Christ and the everlasting nature of the Word of God. In addition, plans are to have a landscaped area with benches inviting people to have a seat that they meditate on the truths of God's Holy Word. **GIFTS ARE BEING RECEIVED** throughout October and November of 2017 to fund this project. The estimated cost is between \$8,000.00 and \$10,000.00. Over \$5000.00 has already been pledged!

Adult Sunday School Class TACTICS IN DEFENDING THE FAITH - TODAY at Legacy

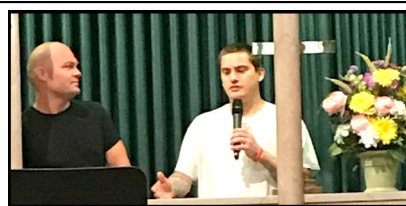
Our Congregational Care and Fellowship Department has begun a new ministry named GriefShare. Grief-
