Missions in a Minute

Community Meal: Continues to be held the 2nd and 3rd Saturdays of every month. We have noticed an increase in amount of people attending. At the October 14 meal, we had almost 90 people attend. This is a unique hospitality ministry that opens opportunities in our neighborhood to be the hands and feet of God. Volunteers are always welcome.

Pastor Brandon Stephenson: A Timothy of NSCC has started his own Church, One Church. At the September meeting, the missions department voted to give \$250/month, starting in January 2018 and reviewed for January 2019. These funds will be given directly to Brandon and his family as they get started.

Jon and Bonna Ray: Are back on the road with their RV Ministry, RVICS. The Missions team voted in August to give \$100/month, to start September 2017 and be reviewed for September 2018.

Casa Por Cristo: In July funds increased to \$400/month. To be reviewed July 2018.

OCI and Trinity International: will have a decrease in funds, starting in Jan 2018 and reviewed January 2019.

Undesignated fund: \$100/month will be started in January 2018. This fund will be used for emergency missions, such as local disaster relief and any other unexpected circumstances to be determined between Pastor Bob, Matt Eckert and Dane Kerr. All Missions will be reviewed annually prior to their one year anniversary date.
