The monument will be over 5 feet tall and 40 inches wide and become the centerpiece of our Church yard. It will be dedicated to the glory of God, the advancement of the Gospel of Jesus Christ and the everlasting nature of the Word of God. In addition, plans are to have a landscaped area with benches inviting people to have a seat that they meditate on the truths of God's Holy Word. **GIFTS ARE BEING RECEIVED** throughout October and November of 2017 to fund this project. The estimated cost is between \$8,000 and \$10,000. Over \$5000. has already been pledged!
