

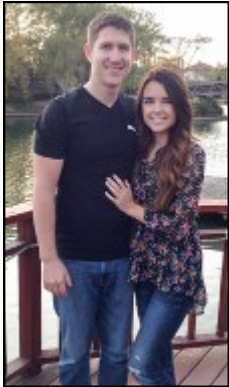
# North Street News
