SHEPHERD OF MY HEART PRESCHOOL SPAGHETTI DINNER

One of the great ministries we have here at NSCC is the **Shepherd of My Heart Christian Preschool**. We have a M-W-F Bible-based Christian Education program for Pre-K kids and on T-TH we have a similar program for pre-schoolers. We presently minister to over 20 families and our enrollment is typically full with a waiting list. This ministry employs one teacher and three helpers. They are Fi Saeler, Debbie Moyer, Tina Rader and Brandi Garbinski. Our Preschool Board includes Chairwoman Kathy Twerdok and Board Members Barb Carson, Marlene Winters, Tina Rader and Kasey Gaiser. Pastor Bob serves as the school Principal and also sits on the board. NSCC provides the space and utilities and some additional costs for the expenses of the preschool. The funding of Shepherd of My Heart Christian Preschool is generated from three sources – tuition, donations and fundraising. Tuition produces 85% - 90% of the funds needed to meet the annual expenses. Donations are received from time to time but are not solicited through any ongoing effort. Fundraising efforts typically provide \$2500.00 - \$4500.00 per year for the school. A new fundraiser this year is announced below – and WE CAN USE YOU HELP!
