VBS is JUNE 17 - 21!

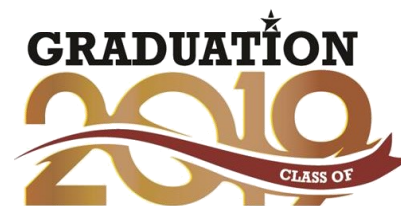

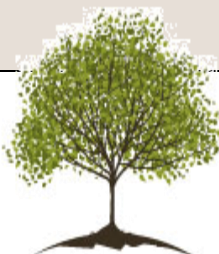
GRADUATION RECOGNITION
