It is better to trust in the LORD than to put confidence in man.

Psalm 118:8

In the past three weeks the truth of Psalm 118:8 resounds. The Lord has laid it upon my heart. "It is better to trust in the LORD than to put confidence in man." I say it several times a day - sometimes out loud! I hear it in my head!

In my lifetime, I do not remember the ongoing, daily, "in your face" need to take notice and remind myself of our need for God as ever before. The constant reminder has of course been caused by living (so far) through a worldwide pandemic brought on by the threat of disease that can end in death.

We have moved from the daily comfort of living by ease to the daily chance of dying from dis-ease. Family life has changed. Education has changed. Shopping has changed. Travel has changed. Medicine has changed. A promising "better than ever" economy is now limping toward recovery on the best of terms. Everything has changed!

Any previous crisis of my day never entered my world so personally. Earthquakes, tsunamis, hurricanes and tornadoes - even wars were always "somewhere else" and appeared to be "somebody else's" problem. The people who lived wherever "there" happened to be, lived (or died) through it, but from my safe perspective "man" found a way to quickly resolve the issues at hand with resourcefulness, money and manpower. The daily news gave me confidence that things would get better and have no real affect on my ongoing "ease."

This time - not so! "Man" is smart, resourceful, abundant and has funds - but does not have the power of life and death in his hands. We ought to be (with good sense) praying for, trusting and following our leaders through this medical maze but be looking to God alone for a confidence that will not fail even if all of "man's" efforts put together should. His power and promises go beyond this world. Let us find our confidence in Him alone - for this day and into eternity!


NSCC Facebook A Word of Encouragement




