GAME NIGHT FOR KIDS

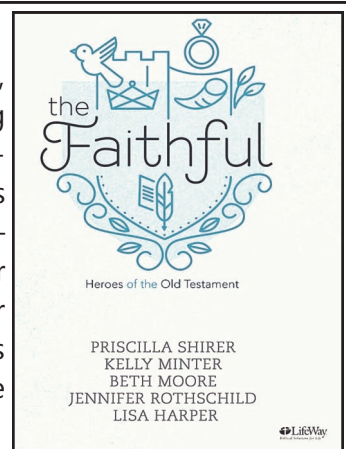
