The Gospel of John Sermon Series

Strength Through Sorrow

Sorrow is a normal human emotion. We all face sorrow, and you're expected to deal with sorrow over certain circumstances. In Genesis 23 we see Abraham weep over the death of Sarah his wife. The apostle Paul was filled with sorrow over the church that he cared about so much (Acts 20). Isaiah 53 tells us that Jesus was a man of sorrow, acquainted with grief. So while sorrow is natural and expected, it is not an excuse for a lack of trust. In difficult times we must not forget what Christ promised the apostles in John 14:26-27, He has left us a comforter, His very peace in the Holy Spirit. While we deal with our human emotions here, allow Revelation 21:4 to be the hope you look to. "and He will wipe away every tear from their eyes, and there will no longer be any death, there will no longer be any mourning, or crying, or pain, for the former things have passed away."
