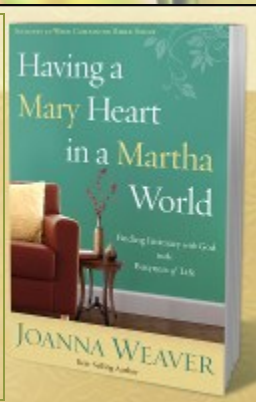

CLIENT STORY: Recently a young woman visited one of our clinics. She was concerned she may be pregnant but unsure as she was already caring for her infant. A specimen was collected and the test was positive, bringing her reality crashing down around her. She was already struggling to get by and could see no possible way to take care of another child. The option of abortion became a very real option for this young woman as she could see no other way to get by in life and she wanted to have it done as soon as possible. The loving staff sat with her, listened to all of her concerns and worries and educated her on all of her options. This included providing local resources that can help her care for her current child as well. She had an ultrasound that day but needed to have another one to re-check some things a week later. However, she didn't show up and we could not get in contact with her. To our surprise she walked back into the clinic about a month later for the ultrasound she missed. Still believing that abortion was the only option for her and with emotions already running high the client received her ultrasound that day. What was revealed to her during this time was a beautiful baby. Watching the screen with tears in her eyes she said, "I can't do this, we need to talk about adoption!" This Mom fell in love with her baby and has made an official plan to parent, so excited to add to her family.
