REMISSION

*For this is My blood of the new covenant,
which is shed for many for the REMISSION of sins.*

Matthew 26:28

Over the last several months my body has been in a battle to put lymphoma cancer into REMISSION. I could not protect myself from the cancer cells of lymphoma. I had to seek outside help beyond my body's physical ability.

Chemotherapy regimen #1 indicated a good response early on but then seven weeks after the 6th treatment my system came out of REMISSION as the cancer had returned. That condition is labeled Primary Refractory Disease. Chemotherapy regimen #2 showed a mixed response (improvement in some areas while other areas worsened) after 2 sessions. Chemotherapy regimen #3 has begun! The Dr. and his team are very hopeful, even confident, that this regimen will put the cancer of my lymphatic system into complete REMISSION! After that occurs, the plan is to go for a cure through an allogenic stem cell transplant!

BTW- In addition to all that is being done for me, I pray daily to be miraculously healed. I also pray for God's grace to flow into and out of my life and for strength and for usability and for attitude and for patience. In addition, I pray concerning various Gospel and Church related matters as well as for many other people.

Now let's get back to REMISSION. In the cancer treatment field REMISSION means the patient has either little or no sign of cancer. It doesn't show up on X-rays, scans, or blood tests. It does not mean all cancer cells have been eliminated, although symptoms of pain and fatigue often disappear.

REMISSION as a Bible word means to be released from (remitted of) the guilt and penalty of sin. SPIRITUAL REMISSION is not attainable by any effort of man. Outside help is needed to cure the cancer of sin. That source is the redeeming blood of Jesus Christ! It is only by His sacrifice on the cross of Calvary, that the REMISSION of sins is possible. His shed blood is the once for all cure for the curse of sin!

I like to remember it this way:

The penalty of my sin was removed at my salvation.

The power of sin is now being removed during my sanctification.

The presence of sin will be removed at my glorification.

"For all have sinned, and come short of the glory of God; Being justified freely by his grace through the redemption that is in Christ Jesus: Whom God hath set forth to be a propitiation through faith in his blood, to declare his righteousness for the REMISSION of sins that are past, through the forbearance of God; To declare, I say, at this time his righteousness: that he might be just, and the justifier of him which believeth in Jesus." Romans 3:23-26
