Man Sins, God Saves

Through our study of the book of John we are often taking about the sovereignty of God. God is sovereign, and the Bible is very clear on that fact. Therefore, you may find yourself wondering how our sin fits in and who is responsible for it. The Bible is clear that when God created the world it was "very good" (Genesis 1:31). Because the Bible is true, we can conclude that sin didn't come from God, everything that came from God was very good. **John Calvin** put it like this - "**God had put His stamp of approval on what had come forth from himself. By his own evil intention, then, man corrupted the pure nature he had received from the Lord.**" So sin, being the absence of moral perfection, puts the responsibility completely on the creature committing it. Therefore, God, who is sovereign, knew that sin would happen, and planned for it as He intended to save from it, yet He is not the author of it. Man sins, God saves, and we must trust His plan. - Jake

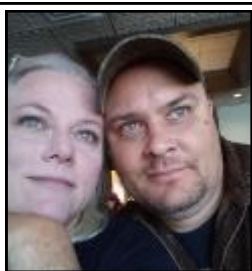
