ANNUAL CONGREGATIONAL MEETING TODAY ~ Sunday, February 14, following Worship



We are continuing our five week series from Ephesians 4. Ephesians 4 is a monumental chapter in your Bible for what the church is, and what the job of the pastor is. God has used this chapter to shape my understanding of what my role is here at North Street. Throughout this short series, we will talk about the unity of the church, the uniqueness of the members in the church, the role of the Pastor, and finally what our life and walk as Christians looks like.

Submission to God's Word

Expository preaching is to set forth the meaning of the text through the delivery of a sermon. This is how we preach here at North Street and we do it for six main reasons.

- 1- Its the example we see in the Bible
- 2- It establishes the authority of God over those hearing
- 3- Christ is the Head of the church
- 4- The Holy Spirit works in accordance with the Word of God
- 5- **It shows submission to God's Word**

The Word of God is powerful. Scripture is our complete and perfect revelation from God himself. He gave us exactly what we needed to know Him and know how to live. When a preacher goes verse by verse through the Bible, it allows scripture to do the teaching. When people learn scripture correctly it changes their lives.

2 timothy 3:16-17 - "All Scripture is given by inspiration of God, and is profitable for doctrine, for reproof, for correction, for instruction in righteousness, that the man of God may be complete, thoroughly equipped for every good work."

God promised in scripture, that the Bible can equip us completely for anything we are expected to do. Instead of looking for other resources, or submitting to man's opinions, we should long to know truth from the Bible, and submit to that perfect truth. Expository preaching lays the meaning of God's word before the listener and shows submission to the words that are from God Himself. Next week, we will look at the sixth and final reason that we study the Bible this way.


