EXPOSITORY PREACHING, WHY DO WE DO IT?

Expository preaching is to set forth the meaning of the text before the listener while delivering a sermon. We are purposefully practicing this here at North Street for six main reasons.

1. ~ It's the example we see in the Bible
2. ~ **It establishes the authority of God over those hearing**

Preachers do not have authority. There is no special standard that allows them to rule over anyone. Jesus Christ does have authority, therefore His word carries that authority. Since Jesus is the head of the church, not the man up front speaking, then Christ should be the one that gets to speak to the church. Christ speaks through scripture. When a preacher stands before a group of people and explains every verse with its intended meaning, it allows Christ to speak to His church through the explanation of the Word of God. So you see, expository preaching establishes the authority of God because it is His word being set forth.

Ephesians 1:22- *“and He put all things under His feet, and gave Him to be head over all things to the church”*
