

SUFFER WELL

We are looking at some passages that talk about suffering. The thought of suffering as a Christian always takes my mind to 2 Corinthians 4:17. "For our momentary, light affliction is producing for us an eternal weight of glory far beyond all comparison." It's a great verse, but I often think we read it wrong in our brains. The passage doesn't say, our momentary light affliction is followed by an eternal weight of glory. That would be enough if that were what it said, but the passage is even better than that. The passage says these momentary light afflictions are PRODUCING FOR US an eternal weight of glory. That means the affliction or the suffering is causing to bring about or preparing the eternal weight of glory. When you can see this, it changes everything for you in how you suffer. This means that your suffering isn't wasted. It means your suffering isn't random. This means your suffering isn't meaningless. Now you don't get to see what it's doing, that's not for you right now. But through faith, you hold onto the promise that it produces for your eternal future and suffer well.
