Biblical Submission

It's easy to submit to perfect leadership. The church flourishes under gleeful submission to Jesus Christ. It's easy to submit to Him, He is good. We know that He is for us, has purchased us with his life, and holds us. In the same way, a healthy marriage has a woman in joyful submission to her husband because he cares for her and loves her. He leads with her best interest in mind. But what about when we are called to submit to something that is far from good leadership? The Bible calls us to submit to government authority. No matter what government is in place, the Christian is to submit believing that God is sovereign and ordained that government. The Bible doesn't give qualifications or conditions to that submission, it's instructing us to honor God by honoring those in authority. Romans 13 lays out the role of government. It says that they are supposed to punish those doing evil and praise those who do good. Just a few years ago, those in authority were punishing innocent people for gathering together and releasing prisoners for no reason. But, regardless of the foolishness of men who are in leadership, God has instructed us to honor them as leaders. Today we will see a little more about that in 1 Peter 2:13-17.
