A simple outline for the Book of Romans could be played out like this: Condemnation - v.1:18 - 3:20, Justification - v.3:21 - 5:21, Sanctification - v.6:1 - 8:39, Restoration - v.9:1 - 11:36, Application - v.12:1 - 15:13. Now, without elaborating on any of those things, if you have any knowledge of what those words mean you should be excited for the Book of Romans. Let's rejoice through this wonderful book together and clearly define a foundation of good theology.
