LOVE GOD LOVE PEOPLE—HERE AND NOW!

REACTING TO PEOPLE – LIKE JESUS DID!

The Bible says, “Jesus went through all the towns and villages, teaching in their synagogues, preaching the good news of the kingdom and healing every disease and sickness. When he saw the crowds, he had **compassion** on them, because they were harassed and helpless, like sheep without a shepherd.

Sometimes people really tick me off – how about you? I mean they seem to be so set in their ways and you try to help them and they just keep going back to doing what they have always done! The saying is true – “if you always do what you’ve always done, you’ll always get what you’ve always got!” Boy can I see that in other people, can’t you? It seems to me that they can’t shake the idea that it’s all about them and their needs and that everybody else should understand their thoughts and ways and learn to see it from their perspective. Even when you help them – sometimes they

don’t even say “thanks.” People sure are focused on self aren’t they! Sometimes, that ticks me off – how about you?

I am glad that Jesus walked this earth and showed us the way and the truth and the life. He didn’t get ticked off at hurting and desperate people – He had compassion on them instead! Because He did, sometimes I have compassion on those same people – don’t you? Who am I to blame someone for drowning ? If I came upon someone literally drowning in water – I wouldn’t ask how that happened and if it were “their own fault” – say “Sorry, I can’t help you under these circumstances!” So who do I think I am deciding who is worthy of another chance, more grace, or God’s flat out love?

Jesus saw people as being harassed and helpless. Spiritually, it was like they had given up and had laid down

to die. They were rejected and neglected and scattered here and there all along the way! HE didn’t rip on them or chew them out or blame them did He? HE had COMPASSION! He was moved from the very inmost of His “bowels.” Because of their distress, He was drawn and agitated with His whole intestinal canal! Such pity increases the motion of the bowels, and produces considerable pain – HE had spasms in the gut, their plight hurt Him so badly!

I want to be like Jesus, don’t you? It makes the most sense when I remember that I’m a people too! And He has compassion on me all of the time – even when it’s my fault! Let us not grow weary in doing the right thing and with the right motivation. Have compassion of people this week – o.k.?
