CONFESSON:

Clearing Your Debt With God and Others

In my former days, living as a Roman Catholic, I was taught and practiced "going to confession" once a week. The idea was that I would confess my sins (against God and against others) to the priest so that he could mediate for me to gain forgiveness before I could partake of the sacrament of the Eucharist on Sunday. (Now I am not

sure that is the official stance, but that's what was in my mind as young Catholic.) Of course, these days I have come to understand that biblically, as a redeemed believer in Christ, I have direct access to the Father through the Son and no longer need to have a human mediator seek forgiveness of my behalf but have the "once for all" Mediator - our great High Priest and the Lamb of God - Jesus Christ to represent my case to the Father.

BUT - I learned a lot about the connection between CONFESSON and a CLEAR CONSCIENCE as a kid. As I walked to the Church to make my weekly confessions and get my penance assignment - I was burdened and after I had made my confession and did my penance - I was lighter and refreshed. (I should have taken communion right then and there because by the next day I was already *heavily indebted to God and people* - I had trespassed and had need to be forgiven all over again!) Anyhow, I usually whistled on the walk home after confessing and doing my penance - I felt so good!

We are yet to confess our sins to God and to others. When we do not - our conscience is not clear and we carry our spiritual debts around with us. There is a burden from sin not forgiven. I want to encourage you to clear your conscience with God and man - and get out of spiritual debt - you'll feel much better with a clear conscience.

In Acts 24:16 the Apostle Paul said, " . . . I myself always strive to have a conscience without offense toward God and men."

James said, "Therefore confess your sins to each other and pray for each other . . . "

John said, "If we claim to be without sin, we deceive ourselves and the truth is not in us. If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just and will forgive us our sins and purify us from all unrighteousness."

Clear your accounts with God and man - you'll feel so much better!
