# MESSIAH IN THE PASSOVER


You are invited to attend the Messiah in the Passover presentation at North Street Christian Church on April 1st at 6:30 p.m. This program, led by Jeff Kipp, a Messianic Jew serving at Yeshua Ben David in Pittsburgh's Jewish Community of Squirrel Hill, depicts Israel's freedom from slavery in Egypt and the redemption of individuals from the bondage of sin through the atoning work of Jesus.

Originating from Brooklyn, and starting out as a rebellious Jewish hippie searching for the meaning of life, Pastor Kipp found Jesus through a series of events following his arrival in Taos, New Mexico. By providence he was led to a Jesus freak hangout where he first heard that Jesus is the Jewish Messiah. He received Jesus into his heart and life.

Continuing to travel, he was led to a Christian Community in Northern California called Lighthouse Ranch where he received a calling to evangelize his Jewish people. He met his wife there and later moved to her hometown of Minneapolis where they became involved with the Messianic Movement.

The Kipps relocated to Pittsburgh and besides leading the Congregation Yeshua Ben David that they began, they work in the private sector to supplement their income. Pastor Kipp is a school bus driver, his wife works at the University of Pittsburgh, his son is a student there and his daughter is a hair stylist.
