In order to accommodate the school schedule in Thailand, our group has been asked to come in mid - February rather than mid - March!

That of course puts our preparation schedule in fast forward. Please pray for the group as preparations are made for our departure and ministry there. We will now need funds to help with some construction in addition to travel and expense funds. The group will be helping with Church construction in Nuang Kiew, a Lahu Village, along with holding worship and teaching children. In addition they will work with the Children's Ministry in Chiang Dao and also visit various other Hill Tribe Village Churches. This is another adventure for God where lives will be changed!


