THAILAND REPORT

From Barnabas Seangsirikhun

With thankful heart sending greetings to you in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ.

I am willing to share the Gospel whether in day time or night. Thank you for your allowance for my family daily living that I can preach the Gospel. Many people heard the first Gospel from my life.

Recently a Thai young girl 10, 5th grade accepted Jesus and the following day I approached a fellow and he decided accepted Jesus Christ. His is named Mic as he was born in McCormick hospital. He is about 45 years old. That night I went to medicated herbal medicine to a fellow and shared the Gospel till 10:30 pm. As soon as I fetch up my kids I left them at home and I went out for preaching at 6 pm.

Chasi, Lahu preacher called me to preached in their Thanks Giving in this coming Saturday. That means I have to travel to more villages as the harvest season comes. The Christmas (witnessing for Christ's born) will be followed after this.

In this year we have Witnessing For Christ's Born in

1. Payangam on December 6
2. Thamakian on December 11
3. Chiangmai on December 13
4. Nong Taung on December 20-23

I have to prepare the electric and sound system, and build the stages and traveling and our three trucks will be running from November to January.

Please help us that we can preach the Gospel in Christmas

Christmas in Refugee Camp

I was invited and asked help from refugee camp for couple years but as I don't have budget I couldn't go down there.

This year if our Church (NCC) willing to support me, I would like to go down and preach the Gospel to refugees. So please remember this in your prayers.

If we go, we go by team, all our evangelists about 20 will be going.

We will buy some gifts, and medicines, and

food for them.

We will be singing and preaching and praying As it is Burmese speaking camp, no problem for me.

I will bring Burmese Bible to them also.

So please pray for us if it is the will of God, we would like to serve him in the refugee camp.

Another great challenging is that the Karen leaders asked me to run an orphanage there as they have been fighting with Burmese soldiers for 60 years. There won't be any doubt that they have many orphans. What shall we do? Are we called to do this ministry?

There are still great numbers that not registered in UN record. Those are still need their daily food.

I am the Asia window for North Street Christian Church to reach the people by the Word of God in Asia.


