PB, Dale Riemer and Andy Bilowich depart for Chiang Mai, Thailand tomorrow morning February 15. The route will take them from Pittsburgh to Chicago to Tokyo to Bangkok to Chiang Mai, arriving Wednesday morning. The group work side by side with and encourage all involved with the ministry of Barnabas and Martha Seangsirikhun. Besides working with the Chiang Mai Church which now meets on the same property as the Seangsirikhun's home, the group will visit many of the Hill Tribe Churches in the mountains to the north. Pastor Bob will address the Thai and Hill Tribe Pastors who have been recruited and trained by Barnabas. Presently the ministry is working to complete the Church building in Hui Ko, an Ahka village and is also raising funds to build a larger Church building in Nuang Kiew, a Lahu village. Funds are being received for these projects presently. The group will return March 2nd.


**TWO NSCC STUDENTS CHOSEN “YOUNG MUSICIAN OF NOTE”**

Rabbi Jeff and his wife Kathy moved to Pittsburgh in 1993 and pioneered and led Congregation Shoresh David from 1994 to 2004 and in 2005 they planted Congregation Yeshua Ben David. Rabbi Jeff is also a staff evangelist for Chosen People Ministries based in New York City. Rabbi Jeff and his wife Kathy reside in Monroeville, Pa. a suburb of Pittsburgh.
