ELECTIVE CLASS DESCRIPTIONS

I, II, and III John and Jude—A Class led by Bob Ogden—Room 101/Library

This class will be exploring Jesus' coming in the flesh, forgiveness and of God's Love. John exhorts us to, "walk in the light", we will learn how to do this.
