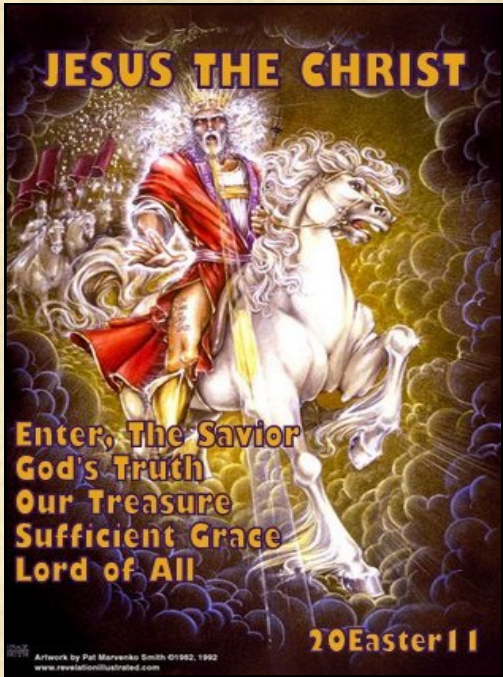

### EASTER SUNDAY SCHEDULE

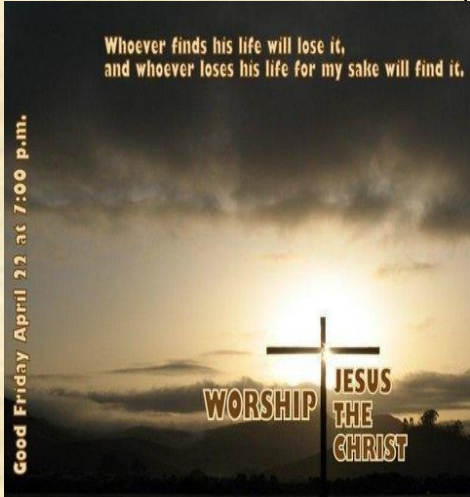

### GOOD FRIDAY AT 7:00 EVENING — WORSHIP JESUS THE CHRIST

THINGS YOU CANNOT EXPECT FROM GOD



Recently I read an article by Perry Ellis entitled **7 Things You Can't Expect As A Church Leader**. After reading the list, I concluded that I agree with what was said but that it is not only true for Church leaders but for everyone who stands to follow Christ and lead others toward Him. So here's the list (with my comments in italicized print) – let it speak to your faithfulness in obedience to Him today!

I cannot expect:

- to win arguments with those who don't want to settle the argument, they just want to fight for the sake of fighting. *Some people are like that – and it is not a spiritual gift by the way! And when they won't change, it is best to stay away from them.* (II Timothy 2:23)
- people to read my mind. *As a visionary, who dreams and dreams, somehow I expect that people will see my vision and agree with it the first time I express it. I need to be a better communicator.* (I Corin-

thians 14:8)

- to have a complete and detailed plan from God that tells me exactly what His plans are for the next 20 years. He doesn't promise to let us see years in advance, but He does promise to show us our next step! *If I just keep breathing in and out and putting one foot in front of the other – I'll make it. Whether walking around the block or 100 miles, both are accomplished the same - just one step at a time!* (Psalm 119:105)
- to be a follower of Jesus and keep everyone around me happy at the same time. *In fact the opposite is true. The strong commitment of one person can tick off a lot of other people. Never did like it – but have sorta' gotten accustomed to it!* (Proverbs 29:25)
- to stay the same and see progress. *Only Jesus Christ is the same yesterday, today and forever! Dead things never change – living things are always changing.* (Isaiah 43:18-19)
- to please God without taking steps of faith. *To be with one church for 30 thirty years does not mean I do not walk by faith – it means I MUST walk by faith! Faith walking is the consistent thing - as with 75 year old Abraham who took step one not knowing where he was going - I must do that again and again.* ( Hebrews 11:6, 8).
- to hear God's voice if I am always running at an unsustainable pace! *Just told Kathi – “we are not setting a very good example of a living a settled lifestyle” and “now that we are “older” this should be a goal of ours – to be still and listen to Him more intently!” God-liness with contentment is our gain.* (Psalm 46:10)
