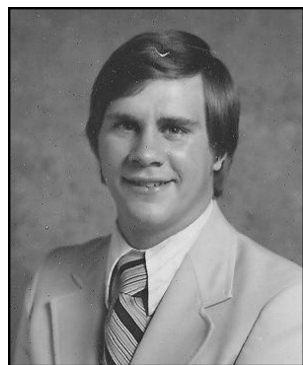

BOB AND KATHI HUBER CELEBRATE 39 YEARS OF MARRIAGE

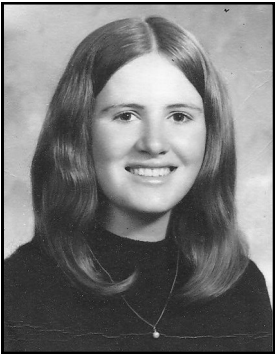
