THE MESSIAH AND THE PASSOVER

JEWISH SEDER MEAL WITH PASTOR JEFF KIPP
Tuesday, April 12th AT 6:30



On Tuesday, April 12 at 6:30, we will hold a traditional Jewish Seder Meal with Guest Speaker Rabbi/Pastor Jeff Kipp of Chosen People Ministries who will speak on the subject, The Messiah in the Passover. There will be only 90 free tickets and they are now available. Each reserved seat must include the name of who is using the ticket.

As in all Biblical holidays, Passover is both a holiday of remembrance and a holiday of prophecy. Passover for the Jewish people is the annual celebration of God delivering Israel out of Egypt (Exodus 12). The entire service, with its various ceremonies, is designed to help the Jewish people remember the great workings of God when, through signs and wonders, He freed the Jewish people from the bondage of the Egyptians and delivered them to the promised land of Israel. Passover is a holiday of redemption picturing how God used the death of an innocent lamb to redeem the firstborn sons of Israel from death and free the nation of Israel from slavery.

Passover is certainly the most important Biblical holiday for Christians. It also clearly pictures the redemption Jesus provided for our sin. The last meal Jesus ate with His disciples in the Upper Room was a Passover meal. It was during this Passover meal that Jesus took a piece of unleavened bread and a cup of the fruit of the vine and said to His disciples that these represented His body given in death and His blood shed for the remission of sins (Luke 22:19, 20). The Messiah used the story of the redemption from Egypt to illustrate the redemption Jesus provided for us on the cross. A Passover dinner is a beautiful opportunity to celebrate the death and resurrection of the Lord Jesus in its historical, New Testament setting as it was celebrated by the disciples with the Messiah. We can rejoice "For Christ our Passover lamb has been sacrificed for us" (I Corinthians 5:7).

Easter commemorates the death and burial and resurrection of the Lord Jesus, and as a remembrance of this event, Christians participate in what we call Communion or the Lord's Supper. The "Lord's Supper" for the most of us is taking of grape juice and a wafer...but the ORIGINAL Lord's Supper was the entire Passover meal. The Passover looks back at the deliverance of the Jewish people from the power of Pharaoh just as communion looks back at our deliverance from the power of sin. Participating in a Passover meal adds to our understanding about the significance of Communion. The traditional Passover celebrated by Jews worldwide today is essentially the SAME meal that Jesus celebrated with the disciples on the night He was betrayed.
