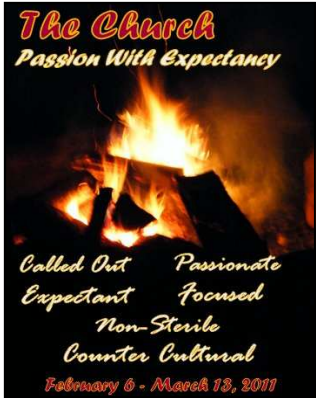

Message: The Church—Passion with Expectancy – Called Out



Pastor Bob will be sharing six messages, February 6 – March 13th, from a new series entitled The Church: Passion With Expectancy. By considering six adjectives which describe the church, the messages will lead us to look in on the church of the New Testament in the Book of Acts to discover that God moved the hearts and minds of people to radical life change. He opened the door of the church era on the Day of Pentecost in AD 30 and His call and purpose remain the same – through the power of His Holy Spirit.

The six messages are:

Called Out – from Acts 2, we will discover that the very name church (ecclesia) means “called out ones.” It means “called out” for a purpose. The church became the new assembly – sort of new *synagogue*. It means “called out ones” from the world into the kingdom of Jesus Christ. Identifying with the church was not seen simply as joining a new religion, but experiencing new life – both inwardly and outwardly.

Passionate – beginning in Acts 5:40-42, we will find that the chief leaders of the “called out ones” were committed to the purpose and message of the church. They counted themselves worthy to suffer because of the name of Jesus. Their passion was contagious!

Expectant – the early church met house to house day to day. Prayer meetings were the norm, church buildings and professional pastors were not. Acts 12 will let us in on the expectancy of those prayer meetings. Even then – a surprise from God was not unusual!

Focused – keeping the main thing, the main thing is the main thing! Early on, even in God’s church – there was tendency to get wrapped up in the lesser things. From Acts 15, we will find that a major conference was called to settle a debate over whether a particular surgical procedure was necessary in order to be identified as a Christian – NOT! In order to emphasize the focused drive of the early church we’ll journey back to Acts 8 to find that there was no mistake about the church being a God thing – and it couldn’t be bought!

Non-sterile – was and is the contagious condition of the true church. God’s church is not a Holy Huddle! Men like Saul – the murderous religious fanatic – we are made new and used by God to share His grace and love. Acts 9 will tell His story. If you want to maintain a weak immune system – stay away – you just might catch something here!

Counter Cultural – the early church became known as The Way and had earned the reputation of being led by some men who were “turning the world upside down!” Even the name “Christian” may have been seen as a derisive term identifying the church people as those of the “party of Christ.” For sure – the church was counter cultural – didn’t fit the mold – and to be part of it meant you had to be serious about this one called Jesus. He said He was the Way, the Truth and the Life – really?!?! YEP! They said He died and resurrected and ascended to Heaven. For real? FOR REAL!

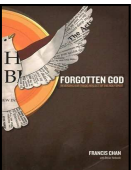
