How sweet are Your words to my taste, sweeter than honey to my mouth! Your word is a lamp to my feet and a light to my path.





BUTLER BIBLE INSTITUTE CLASSES

Butler Bible Institute is scheduling two new classes to begin in February 2011. Check-out the following to see if you are interested in taking either or both. You can call the church office at 724-282-7700 or 724-283-3413 to inquire or speak to the teachers while in church.

Meeting on Tuesdays from 2PM to 4PM for 7 meetings starting February the 8th will be Bibliology 101, which is a study of the Bible as the supreme and incomparable Book that surpasses all other sources of information as a revelation of God. This course earns 1 unit of BBI credit. The teacher for this class will be Bob Ogden.

Meeting on Thursdays from 12:30PM to 2:30PM for 13 meetings starting February 10 will be Eschatology 105, which is the study of the various resurrections, the judgments, and the final state of the unsaved, as revealed to us in Scripture.
