LADIES BIBLE STUDIES

Two Studies Starting January 18th at Legacy

Sam Tait will be leading two Ladies Bible Studies starting Tuesday, January 18th at 10:00 a.m. Each study is 9 weeks and will be held at Legacy, each running about one hour long.

The first is *Living Beyond Yourself by Beth Moore*—a DVD in depth study on the fruit of the Spirit. Beth walks participants through each trait listed in the fruit and encourages women to know the freedom of a Spirit-filled life. Through this study participants will look at the supernatural aspects of the fruit and that you cannot grow, learn, or produce the fruit on your own. Beth challenges you to develop the fruit by maintaining an intimate relationship with the Spirit of God. A Spirit-filled life truly results in living beyond yourself.

The second is *The Inheritance by Beth Moore*—The concept of inheritance isn't just a subject in Scripture. It is a theme stretching all the way from Genesis to Revelation. The word "inheritance" or forms of the word (i.e. inherit, heir, heritage, etc.) can be found in the Word of God no less than 300 times and appears with frequency in both Testaments. This nine session lecture series is a topical study of inheritance throughout God's Word. Each session is approximately one hour in length. Key verses: Psalm 16:5-6 "The lines have fallen for me in pleasant places; indeed, I have a beautiful inheritance." (Please note this series does not have homework)
