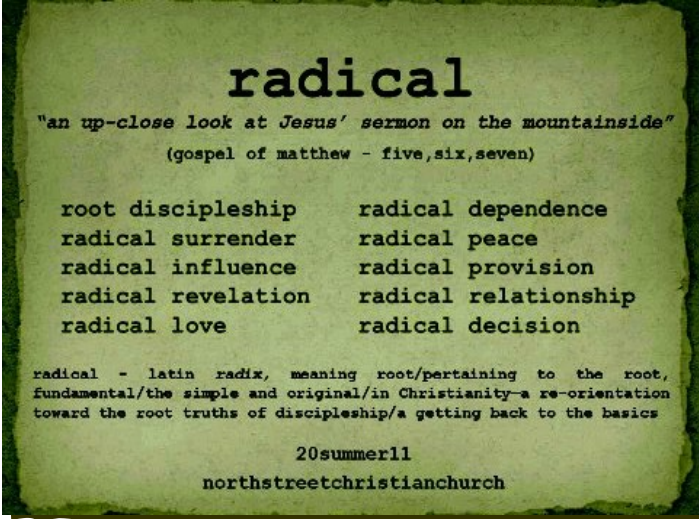

MESSAGE: RADICAL- "The Sermon on the Mountainside" - Radical Influence



NEWS FROM THE PULPIT OF NSCC

As summer progresses, Pastor Bob will continue to help hearers take an up-close look at the deep spiritual truths of the sermon on the mountainside, Jesus' inaugural sermon. The remaining messages are as follows: July 3 - Radical Influence; July 10 - Radical Revelation; July 17 - Radical Love; July 24 - Radical Dependence; August 7 - Radical Peace; August 21 - Radical Provision; September 4 - Radical Relationship and September 11 - Radical Decision. In the sermon on the mountainside, Jesus presented the "root truths" of following Him. These truths minister to the "core" of a man or woman. Rather than challenging His followers to *follow God's law* - the call became *follow Me!* And we find ourselves on that same path even today making for a lifelong pursuit of the spiritual treasure that is ours through Him.

The pulpit will be filled by Bob Ogden on July 31, Dennis Muir on August 28 and Jake Klutiny on October 2.

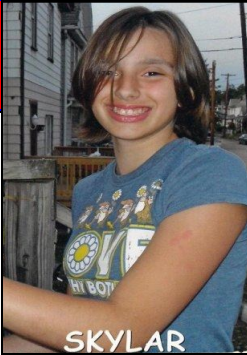


SPAGHETTI DINNER TO BENEFIT SKYLAR MEREDITH July 30th—Donations and Volunteers Needed!

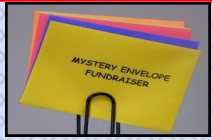
