### NEWS FROM THE PULPIT OF NSCC

Rather than challenging His followers to *follow God's law* - the call became *follow Me!* And we find ourselves on that same path even today making for a lifelong pursuit of the spiritual treasure that is ours through Him.

Now he is the first Christian in this town. Then in the rain with motor bike I headed back. As the gasoline gone on the way back I have to walk to my truck. I was hungry and my dinner was at 10 pm.
