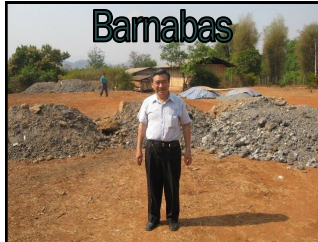
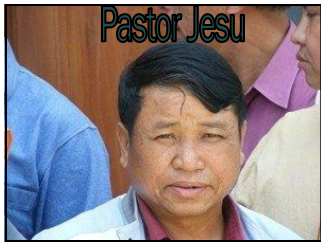
### BUILDING ANOTHER CHURCH IN NORTHERN THAILAND

Nuang Kiew Lahu Village

Through the blessing of the Lord upon the vision and hard work of Barnabas Seangsirikhun and through the generosity of just a few people from NSCC, a new church building has begun to be built in Nuang Kiew - a Lahu village in northern Thailand! Barnabas and Pastor Jesu and congregation are praising God and working hard to accomplish the task.

Barnabas sends this word, "In Nuag Kiew Lahu Church, I built the first Church for them but the first Church couldn't hold the members as it increased. The Church could hold about 70 members but they have 270 members. As the northern region lies on high level and no water. They can cultivate the crops once a year during the raining season only. Hardly able to support their own family. Thank you very much for your offerings to help build a Church for poor Christians that confess the same faith with you. May God bless you according to his promise that sealed with his life."

We thank those who pray daily for our ministry and mission endeavors. We thank those who gave so generously to support this project. The first \$10,000.00 has been wired to fund the project and the second \$10,000.00 is ready to be sent as soon as it is needed!

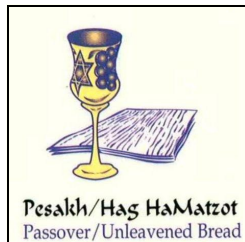


### THE MESSIAH IN THE PASSOVER—JEWISH SEDER MEAL WITH PASTOR JEFF KIPP—Tuesday, April 12th AT 6:30



On Tuesday, April 12 at 6:30, we will hold a traditional Jewish Seder Meal with Guest Speaker Rabbi/Pastor Jeff Kipp of Chosen People Ministries who will speak on the subject, The Messiah in the Passover. There are 90 free tickets and they are now available. Each reserved seat must include the name of who is using the ticket.

Passover is certainly the most important Biblical holiday for Christians. It also clearly pictures the redemption Jesus provided for our sin. The last meal Jesus ate with His disciples in the Upper Room was a Passover meal. It was during this Passover meal that Jesus took a piece of unleavened bread and a cup of the fruit of the vine and said to His disciples that these represented His body given in death and His blood shed for the remission of sins (Luke 22:19, 20). The Messiah used the story of the redemption from Egypt to illustrate the redemption Jesus provided for us on the cross. A Passover dinner is a beautiful opportunity to celebrate the death and resurrection of the Lord Jesus in its historical, New Testament setting as it was celebrated by the disciples with the Messiah. We can rejoice "For Christ our Passover lamb has been sacrificed for us" (I Corinthians 5:7).
