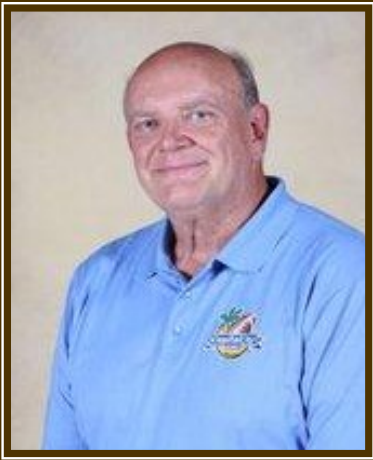

ARE YOU READY FOR YOUR FINAL EXAM?

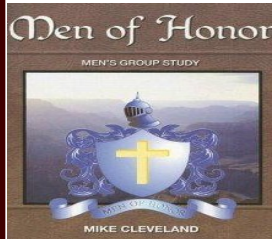
Sunday, November 13 at 8:00 and 10:15

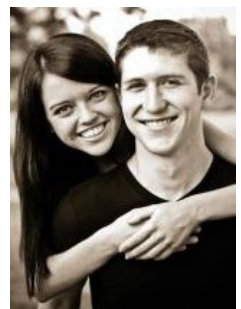

It became easy to navigate the maze when a friend walked alongside giving directions. This demonstrated how misguided and distracted we are when we go through life without listening to God, and the children learned the value of establishing a relationship with God through reading the Bible and praying and being obedient in following His directions.
