## Dr. Roy Yarbrough to Speak at North Street Church

Dr. Roy Yarbrough, Professor of Sport Management at California University says, *"The greatest use of my life is to spend it on people who will out last me. It is better to begin each day thinking victory, and not defeat; to awake to grace, not shame."* Dr. Yarbrough will speak at a Men's Breakfast on Saturday, November 12, and for Chapel Hour and The Gathering For Worship on Sunday Morning, November 13, here at North Street Church. ### Dr. Yarbrough's Message: Are You Ready For Your Final Exam?

Here are some things you ought to know about Dr. Roy Yarbrough: He is retired from the U.S. Coast Guard as a lieutenant commander, serving his country for 26 years in the active and reserve programs.

Dr. Yarbrough's involvement and success in sports began when in 1970 he became an AAU-All American in track and field through the sport of race walking. He was then sanctioned by the U.S. Coast Guard to compete on the U.S. Olympic track team.

He has served with the National Intercollegiate Soccer Officials Association (NISOA) since 1976 and is on its National Academy Training Program staff as a physical fitness adviser and national clinician. He serves on the United States Soccer Federation (USSF) national staff as a physical fitness adviser and referee instructor. In 1990, Dr. Yarbrough had the honor of being inducted into the USA Soccer Hall of Fame.

He has researched and written a book titled "MASCOTS: The History of Senior College & University Mascots/Nicknames" He is currently serving as the senior judge for the Capital One Bowl national mascot championship on New Year's Day. Also, he has been a consultant for the NCAA and for ESPN and ABC sports on mascot-related issues. The May 23, 2003 issue of *Sports Illustrated* has called Dr. Yarbrough the "guru of mascotology."
