
Future Fifth Sunday Fellowships in 2012 are July 29, September 30 and December 30.

FAITH WEAVER FRIENDS


During the past two Wednesday nights Faith Weaver Friends has studied a two part lesson on the Easter story. The first of these two lessons told the story of Jesus' triumphal entry into Jerusalem riding on the colt of a donkey and described the scene as people lay palm fronds and their own cloaks on the ground in front of Him and shouted their praises to God. The Bible verse for the week was Psalm 9:11 "Sing praises to the Lord," and the children got to make their very own donkey hand puppet.

The second lesson studied the Empty Tomb. In preparation for this lesson, the children watched a video depicting the betrayal and crucifixion of Jesus and also the joy experienced by His followers when they found the tomb empty and realized He was risen from the dead! The accompanying Bible verse was Matthew 28:7 "Jesus is risen from the dead," and taught the children to
