## 30 HOUR FAMINE

**MAY 18TH-19TH**

**Fact: A child dies from hunger-related causes every 8 to 12 seconds.**

That's as many as 11,000 children younger than 5yrs old — dying every day from malnutrition.

**Fact: Globally, 925 million people are hungry.**

That's roughly 3 times the population of the U.S. going to bed hungry every night.

**What are we going to do about it?** For 30 short hours the youth of North Street Christian Church will not eat in order to raise funds that will go towards providing hungry families with something to eat. The teens are given mission packets which will be sent to provide food for those that are in need. You can support them with so much per hour (one dollar a hour would add up to 30 dollars) or with a gift of any amount you feel led to bless them with. None of us can do this alone. The famine requires participation and support. As a church lets fight hunger. -Jake
